THE FIGHT AGAINST ABORTION



It's time for us to take a stand against abortion. Even if it's just a short prayer, stand up for all the innocent, defenseless babies who are aborted every single day.





Who will win this vicious war, the BYDC or the BYFC? Or possible, the BYNC?



SHORT STORY


